Session 1: Friday 28th October 2022 Presenter: Rosemary Riddell

My View from the Bench: Laughter, Life and Learning

Rosemary worked as lawyer in Dunedin and District Court Judge in Hamilton. Her love for theatre and film included directing the full length film, The Insatiable Moon, written by her husband Mike.

Legal Outcomes from the Christchurch Earthquake

The roads from home led Emily from Herbert Street to the Hawke's Bay, via Dunedin where she secured a degree in law and history. From family lawyer, to civil litigator, to legal trainer in London instructing the Queen's solicitors in negotiations skills.

After 2 children the roads lead back to Christchurch in time for the Canterbury earthquakes.

After 10 years teaching for the College of Law, Emily returned to legal practice to be involved in two major class actions taken by homeowners against Southern Response.

Emily now sits as a member of the Canterbury Earthquake Insurance Tribunal and runs the relationship property and family law team at Mortlock McCormack Law. A mother of 3 teenagers, wife of an IT specialist, and loving daughter, the roads from home always lead back to where family is.

Presenter: Rod Hall-Jones

Pilot and Author

Rod holds a commercial pilot license for both fixed wing and helicopter, survived the live deer capture days and has flown in more than 20 countries around the world; all after being told he would not make it.

Like his uncle and Grandfather, Rod has put pen to paper and has written a book, his on his life's story recounting the days of an upbringing in Invercargill, live deer recovery and his six years as Jacques Cousteau's Pilot flying off the legendary research ship 'Calypso'.
