COMPOSERS AND THEIR SINGERS

Composers of opera and vocal music depend on good singers for their work to be well received. Many composers have found singers who can interpret their work especially well, or who have voices it is a particular pleasure to compose for. In this series we explore some of the fruitful relationships between composers and their singers.

John Drummond is Emeritus Professor of Music at the University of Otago since 2014. John was appointed Blair Professor of Music in 1976 and held this post until he retired in 2014. He has been involved in a wide range of musical activities within university circles and in the wider community. His many achievements include directing some 40 Opera productions and composing some 10 original works.

Session 1 Friday Mar 5

A Clash of Nightingales

In the 1720's Handel employed the two greatest sopranos of his time for his Royal Academy opera company in London:

Francesca Cuzzoni and Faustina Bordini. Their rivalry became a scandal.

Session 2 Friday Mar 19

A Weakness for Lovely Girls

Mozart fell in love with Aloysia Lange when he was seventeen and wrote beautiful music for her. Nancy Storace was the vivacious young soprano for whom he wrote the role of Susanna in The Marriage of Figaro.

Session 3 Friday Mar 26 A Scandal in Florence

Soprano Teresa Stolz sang the title role in the first European production of Verdi's opera Aida (the premiere was in Cairo). Verdi also coached her for the first performance of his Requiem. But was the coaching only musical?

Session 4 Friday May 14 Be Careful What You Wish For

Wagner chose Albert Niemann to sing Siuegmund in the first production of his Ring Cycle operas but Niemann wasn't the easiest person to work with. When two large personalities come into conflict anything can happen.....
