

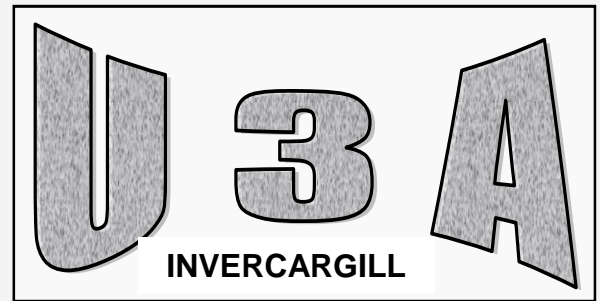

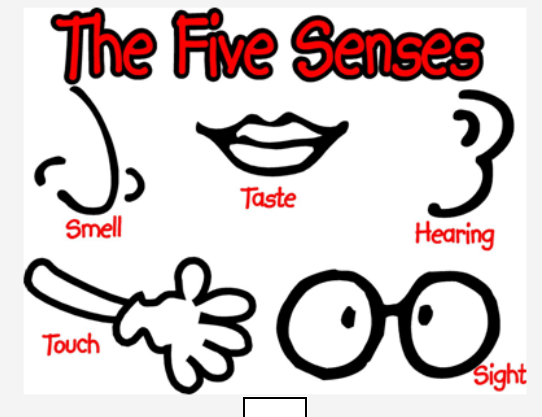

Session 1 Friday March 24
Hearing as we Age
Presenter: Anne McElwain
