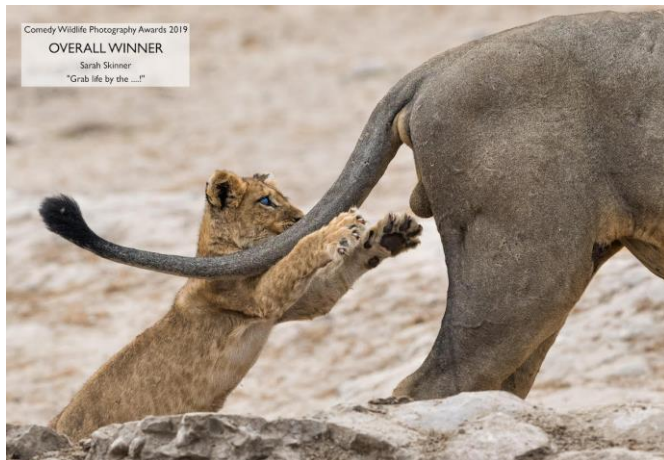

Session 1 Friday Aug 28
Presenter: Graham Dainty
**Seeing the World
in Your Own Way**

Graham is Te Anau based and has been seriously photographing for over 30 years. A part time commercial photographer he gives lectures and workshops on photography. During this time he has been an active member of the Photographic Society of NZ. In 2004 he became a Fellow of the society and recently has done 10 years on the P.S.N.Z Honours Board with most of them as chairman.
